NO HOT CROSS MUMS

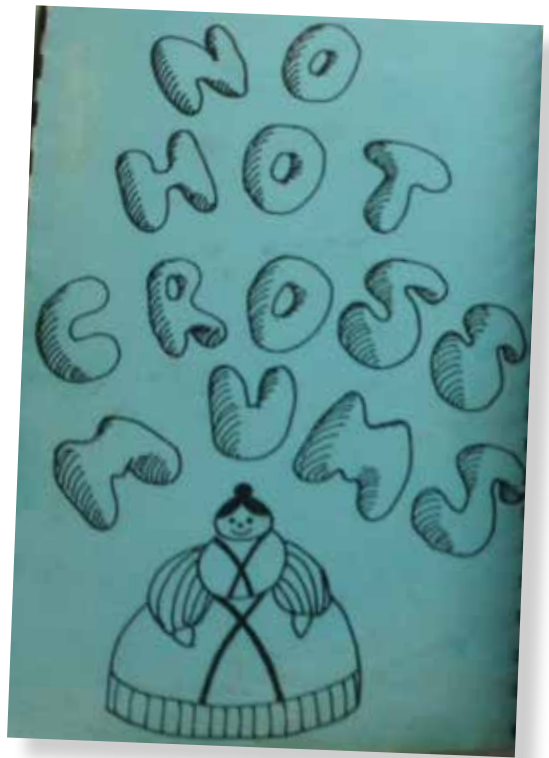
In 1983 young mums who attended the Hintlesham and Chattisham Church Circle collected and published a book of favourite recipes called
